Maybe a priest. Maybe a prophet. Maybe a madman. We don't really know. But Simeon walks into the Temple guided by power of the Holy Spirit and possessed of a vision for this baby Messiah. He prophesies to all who would hear that this child, this Jesus will be the consolation for the nation of Israel—and even further. This Messiah will be for all the Gentiles, will be our peace, will be our salvation, our light and our glory.


