



#### The Sermon

#### **Presentation and Examination of the Candidates**

PARENTS AND GODPARENTS: "I present Charli to receive the Sacrament of Baptism."

CELEBRANT: Will you be responsible for seeing that the child you present is brought up in the Christian faith and life?

PARENTS AND GODPARENTS: I will, with God's help.

CELEBRANT: Will you by your prayers and witness help this child to grow into the full stature of Christ?

PARENTS AND GODPARENTS: I will, with God's help.

CELEBRANT: Do you renounce Satan and all the spiritual forces of wickedness that rebel against God?

PARENTS AND GODPARENTS: I renounce them.

CELEBRANT: Do you renounce the evil powers of this world which corrupt and destroy the creatures of God?

PARENTS AND GODPARENTS: I renounce them.

CELEBRANT: Do you renounce all sinful desires that draw you from the love of God?

PARENTS AND GODPARENTS: I renounce them.

CELEBRANT: Do you turn to Jesus Christ and accept him as your Savior?

PARENTS AND GODPARENTS: I do.

CELEBRANT: Do you put your whole trust in his grace and love?

PARENTS AND GODPARENTS: I do.

CELEBRANT: Do you promise to follow and obey him as your Lord? I do.

CELEBRANT: Will you who witness these vows do all in your power to support Charli, parents and Godparents in her life in Christ?

PEOPLE: We will.

CELEBRANT: Let us join with those who are committing themselves to Christ and renew our own baptismal covenant.

## The Baptismal Covenant

CELEBRANT: Do you believe in God the Father?

PEOPLE: I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth.

CELEBRANT: Do you believe in Jesus Christ, the Son of God?

PEOPLE: I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord. He was conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended to the dead. On the third day he rose again. He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again to judge the living and the dead.

CELEBRANT: Do you believe in God the Holy Spirit?

PEOPLE: I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting.

CELEBRANT: Will you continue in the apostles' teaching and fellowship, in the breaking of bread, and in the prayers?

PEOPLE: I will, with God's help.

CELEBRANT: Will you persevere in resisting evil, and, whenever you fall into sin, repent and return to the Lord?

PEOPLE: I will, with God's help.

CELEBRANT: Will you proclaim by word and example the Good News of God in Christ?

PEOPLE: I will, with God's help.

CELEBRANT: Will you seek and serve Christ in all persons, loving your neighbor as yourself?

PEOPLE: I will, with God's help.

CELEBRANT: Will you strive for justice and peace among all people, and respect the dignity of every human being?

PEOPLE: I will, with God's help.

## **Prayers for the Candidates**

CELEBRANT: Let us now pray for Charli who is to receive the sacrament of new birth.

LEADER: Deliver her, O Lord, from the way of sin and death.

PEOPLE: Lord, hear our prayer.

LEADER: Open her hearts to your grace and truth.

LEADER: Fill her with your holy and life-giving Spirit.

CELEBRANT: Grant, O Lord, that all who are baptized into the death of Jesus Christ your Son may live in the power of his resurrection and look for him to come again in glory; who lives and reigns now and for ever. Amen.

## Thanksgiving over the Water

CELEBRANT: The Lord be with you. PEOPLE: And also with you.

CELEBRANT: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God. PEOPLE: It is right to give him thanks and praise.

CELEBRANT: We thank you, Almighty God, for the gift of water. Over it the Holy Spirit moved in the beginning of creation. Through it you led the children of Israel out of their bondage in Egypt into the land of promise. In it your Son Jesus received the baptism of John and was anointed by the Holy Spirit as the Messiah, the Christ, to lead us, through his death and resurrection, from the bondage of sin into everlasting life.

We thank you, Father, for the water of Baptism. In it we are buried with Christ in his death. By it we share in his resurrection. Through it we are reborn by the Holy Spirit. Therefore in joyful obedience to your Son, we bring into his fellowship those who come to him in faith, baptizing them in the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

Now sanctify this water, we pray you, by the power of your Holy Spirit, that those who here are cleansed from sin and born again may continue for ever in the risen life of Jesus Christ our Savior.

To him, to you, and to the Holy Spirit, be all honor and glory, now and for ever. Amen.

CELEBRANT: Charli, you are sealed by the Holy Spirit in Baptism and marked as Christ's own for ever. Amen.

CELEBRANT AND PEOPLE: We receive you into the household of God. Confess the faith of Christ crucified, proclaim his resurrection, and share with us in his eternal priesthood.






